**Tax Counselor, German Embassy**

Peter Deblon is a tax counselor at the German Embassy. He has held this post since 2010. Prior to his position at the Embassy, Mr. Deblon worked at the German Ministry of Finance, where he coordinated federal tax legislation. He has also served as the desk officer for the state-owned German development bank KfW, the Office of the Parliamentary State Secretary at the Ministry, and the Officer of the Minister of Finance, Dr. Theo Waigel. His duties included monitoring of the Department of Capital Market and Financing of KfW, micro- and macroeconomic analysis of tax law changes, and management of the budget and financial relationship between the states and federal government.

Prior to his service for the German Ministry of Finance, Mr. Deblon served as a research assistant to Dr. Friedman, Chairman of the Audit Committee of the German Bundestag. Mr. Deblon also worked as an audit assistant at a tax consulting firm. Mr. Deblon has a degree in Business with a focus on company auditing, tax law, and finance.
