Alan Granwell has practiced in the area of international taxation for over 40 years. He represents US multinational groups and US high-net worth individuals investing or conducting business abroad, and foreign multinational groups and foreign high net-worth individuals investing or conducting business in the United States. In the past few years, a significant portion of Mr. Granwell's practice has been advising financial institutions on FATCA and on international tax compliance matters.

From 1981 through 1984, Mr. Granwell was the International Tax Counsel and Director, Office of International Tax Affairs at the US Department of the Treasury. In that capacity, Mr. Granwell was the senior international tax advisor at the Treasury Department and was responsible for advising the Assistant Secretary for Tax Policy on legislation, regulations, and administrative matters involving international taxation and directing the US tax treaty program.
