Professor Harvey joined the Villanova faculty on August 1, 2010. He has over 35 years of multifaceted tax experience including: (i) Senior Government Official in the US Treasury Department and Internal Revenue Service during the Reagan, Bush II, and Obama administrations; (ii) Managing Partner at PricewaterhouseCoopers (retired); and (iii) professor at both Bucknell University and The College of New Jersey prior to joining the Villanova faculty.

Immediately prior to joining the Villanova faculty, Professor Harvey was the Senior Advisor to IRS Commissioner Doug Shulman advising on tax administration and policy issues. He was a liaison with the US Treasury Department Office of Tax Policy, Congressional staff, and the Department of Justice and was significantly involved in a wide range of issues including highly publicized IRS efforts to (i) address off-shore tax evasion, and (ii) increase transparency by business taxpayers (i.e., Schedule UTP). Professor Harvey was one of the architects of FATCA and his article titled: *Offshore Accounts: Insider's Summary of FATCA and Its Potential Future* is available at <http://ssrn.com/abstract=1969123>.

In his role at PricewaterhouseCoopers, Professor Harvey was the leader of PwC's US Banking and Capital Markets Tax Practice where he advised large multi-national financial institutions on complex tax and accounting issues. He is a nationally recognized expert in the financial accounting for income taxes (e.g., FAS 109, FIN 48, and IFRS) and was consulted by the FASB upon development of FIN 48

From 1986 to 1988 Professor Harvey was the Senior Accountant in the U.S. Treasury Department, Office of Tax Policy. In this role, he participated extensively in the formulation of the U.S. Treasury Department's tax policy, and the drafting of legislation and regulations, including extensive work on the negotiation and implementation of the 1986 Tax Reform Act.

Professor Harvey is a frequent speaker, including major speeches to the Canadian Tax Foundation, Multistate Tax Commission, American Bar Association, Tax Executive Institute, Wall Street Tax Association, The Clearing House, and Institute for International Bankers.
